





2018 BEYOND SUNDAY SCHOOL GRANT RECIPIENT:

St. Joseph School in Imperial (in collaboration with other area schools) Cultivating Minds and Super School Communities by Creating Innovative STREAM labs

A \$100,000 Beyond Sunday grant funded St. Joseph School's new makerspace lab and robotics program. With these improvements, students are learning to work together to solve problems and developing analytical, critical thinking and leadership skills, all while becoming technologically adept to succeed in a modern world. Because Cultivating Minds was a partnership between several Region 6 Catholic schools and the Clavius Project at St. Louis University High School, students throughout the southern areas of our archdiocese—not just those attending St. Joseph School—are benefiting from the grant.
