Up to 177 new awards granted and 768 current awards renewed for an estimated total of 945 elementary school awards in the 2022-2023 school year!

2022-2023 Income Guidelines and Award Amounts

Note: These award amounts apply to new applicants. Requalifying students shall receive either the award amount for which they would have previously qualified, or the new amount for which they qualify, whichever is greater. Requalifying students whose income is below the minimum for their household size shall be grandfathered.

Students attending private Catholic schools will receive either one-half the award amounts shown or \$500, whichever is greater.

What is the Beyond Sunday Elementary School Scholarship program?

The Beyond Sunday Elementary School Scholarship Program provides tuition support to increase access to Catholic education for middle-income families.

What are the program guidelines?

- To be eligible, families must demonstrate total household income within the income limits above.
- Preference will be given to Catholic students in Catholic families registered in a parish of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Maximum of one Beyond Sunday award per family per school. Families may be eligible for additional scholarship awards through other programs.
- Minimum annual tuition payment of \$500 per student is required. All award amounts will be capped at 50% of tuition, excluding fees.
- Awards renew through 8th grade graduation, upon annual income requalification.
- Awards are transferrable to other Beyond Sunday-eligible elementary schools within the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

What else do I need to know?

- An estimated total of 155 new awards will be granted in kindergarten; an estimated total of 22 new awards will be granted in the remaining grades (first through eighth).
- An estimated 768 currently awarded students will requalify for 2022-2023 scholarships.
