Up to 60 new awards granted and 100 current awards renewed for an estimated total of 160 high school awards in the 2025-2026 school year!

2025-2026 Income Guidelines and Award Amounts

Note: These award amounts apply to new applicants. Requalifying students shall receive either the award amount for which they would have previously qualified, or the new amount for which they qualify, whichever is greater. Requalifying students whose income is below the minimum for their household size shall be grandfathered.

What is the Beyond Sunday Fellows program?

The Beyond Sunday Fellows program is a confluence of young Catholic leaders from high schools throughout the Archdiocese of St. Louis, who desire to grow and support one another in faith and service. In addition to receiving scholarship support, Fellows engage in an annual leadership conference and a service project.

What are the program guidelines?

- To be eligible, families must demonstrate total household income within the income limits above.
- Awards will be made to Catholic students in families registered in a parish of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.
- Maximum of one Beyond Sunday award per family per school. Families may be eligible for additional scholarship awards through other programs.
- Minimum annual tuition payment of \$1,000 per student is required. All award amounts will be capped at 50% of tuition, excluding fees.
- In addition to the standard application for scholarship assistance, applicant must respond to short-answer questions, provide a letter of good standing from pastor and complete an affirmation statement.
- Awards renew through graduation, upon annual income requalification **and participation in a fall Fellows' event and spring service project. Lack of participation will jeopardize renewal of scholarship.**
- Awards are transferrable to other Beyond Sunday-eligible high schools within the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

What else do I need to know?

- Due to high demand and limited resources, selection is competitive and cannot be guaranteed to all applicants.
- An estimated total of 40 new awards will be granted in ninth grade.
- An estimated 100 currently awarded students will requalify for 2025-2026 scholarships.
- The Roman Catholic Foundation manages the annual activities and communication of the Fellows Program.
